Financial Aid for Students

The Cayce/Reilly School is pleased to announce that we are now approved to offer Federal Financial Aid to students who qualify! By offering financial assistance, the school is in a stronger position to attract students who want to attend, but are unable to otherwise afford to. "We already have the reputation for excellence, and now we can match what other schools offer financially," says Director Nancy Hallingse-Smith.

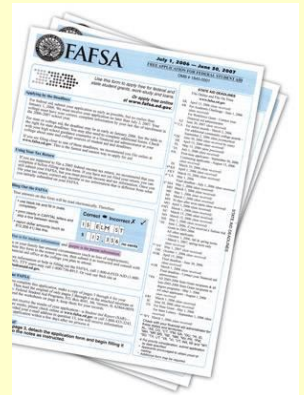
The impact of financial aid to the continued growth of this one-of-a-kind school is tremendous. In 2008, the US Department of Education reported that less than 1,800 postsecondary schools across the country, with a program less than two years were approved to offer Federal Student Aid. The Cayce/Reilly School is proud to be among schools approved to offer this valuable resource for those seeking a career in massage therapy.

Federal Student Aid is financial help for eligible students to pay for educational expenses at an eligible postsecondary school (college, vocational school, graduate school, etc). Federal Student Aid covers expenses such as tuition, fees, books, and supplies. Grants and Student Loans are two categories of student aid available through the Cayce/Reilly School. Grants are awarded to students to assist with tuition costs and they do not have to be repaid. Student Loans are low interest loans for students and parents to help cover the cost of education. Eligibility for financial aid programs such as grants and loans, is determined by the information you provide on the application.

To apply for student financial aid, you need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Applications are completed and submitted online at **www.FAFSA.ed.gov**. On the application you need to add our school code, **041373**, in order for your application information to be sent to our Financial Aid Office.

You will be contacted by the Cayce/Reilly School within two weeks of submitting your FAFSA Application to discuss financial aid packages and awards that you are eligible for, based on the information you submitted on your FAFSA.

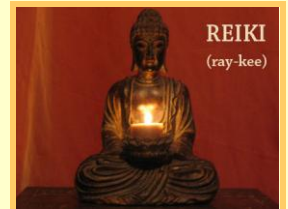

August 1 Reiki I

No prerequisites. This course introduces the scientific and esoteric theories of the breath. The basic principles of the yogi complete breath are covered. August 22-23 Ohashiatsu, Beginning: Part I

Saturday & Sunday 9-5:30pm

Learn the fundamental principles of Ohashiatsu as they apply to bodywork and, more importantly, to every aspect of life. The benefits are immediate as you become calmer, centered and accepting of yourself and others. The course focuses on feeling the life force energy flow in the body and learning the natural movements that are central to Ohashiatsu; locating the energy meridians and some major tsubos (acupoints); and the concept of Yin and Yang (balance).

Basic Jin Shin Do® – Parts I & II **September 3 – November 12** **Thursday evenings from 6-10pm**

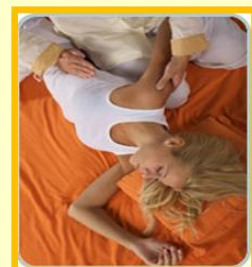
The first half of Jin Shin Do® Basic, Part I includes an introduction to Asian healing philosophy and instruction on locations of fifty-five accupoints.

Part, II includes the study of the eight "strange flows". These are the vessels that help to move and balance the energy in our body. Their functions for total body/mind balance are each discussed with demonstration and practice sessions. To learn more about Jin Shin Do® visit www.jinshindo.org



Introduction to Zen Shiatsu **September 21 & 28** **Monday evenings from 6-10pm**

Embark on an experiential adventure into classical Chinese medical theory and its application to the healing arts, specifically, Zen Shiatsu. Practical Zen Shiatsu techniques will be learned in the prone, supine, lateral, recumbent positions. Abdominal, pulse, and palpatory assessment will also be introduced during the course. Instructor Daniel Johnson, L.Ac, is a Licensed Acupuncturist, Herbalist and Asian Bodywork Therapist specializing in Japanese meridian therapy.



Healing Hands/Healing Oils **October 13** **Tuesday evening from 6-9pm**

This introductory workshop will cover the history and use of nine Young Living Essential Oils for anointing and healing. Laying-on-of-hands chakra healing and a Blessing of the Senses healing will also be practiced in class demonstrations.



Introduction to Tuina (Chinese Medical Massage) **November 2 & 9** **Monday evenings from 6-10pm**

This class is an introduction into an ancient form of Asian bodywork therapy that has been used in China for 2,000 years. Tuina uses the traditional Chinese medical theory that balancing the flow of Qi energy through acupressure points brings the body into balance. Basic techniques will be discussed and demonstrated in practice sessions.
