### Dear Prayer Healing Friends,


Just this week, I received a letter from a dear friend who worked with me here at A.R.E. Headquarters during the 1970s and '80s.

He became a male nurse who spent his life in service, caring for others—first his father, then his mother, and finally, his wife, Rosemary.

He wrote, "Rosemary came to visit me after her death. She walked across the room and glanced at me. I heard her voice say, 'This is how I looked in the '70s.' She was young and healthy. I guess she just wanted to let me know that she was well and renewed."

"Several times I asked God for a new life, a change. Each time I ended up in a caretaker role. It wasn't what I hoped for [but] I guess I got what I needed. I went into nursing to serve God and humanity. It was demanding, stressful, and asked more of me than I wished to give, but I stuck with it."

### **" . . . Teach Them God . . . " and Brotherly Love**

In speaking to the forty or more members attending the Twelfth Annual Congress in Virginia Beach, Mr. Cayce was asked if it would be "feasible to work out an international currency, or an international stabilization of exchange values" and answered that ". . . it'll be a step in the right direction—in the attempts in bringing peace at this time."

He was also questioned about how to ". . . cooperate in setting up an international police force . . ." so as not to antagonize our "recent enemies." The answer given was, "These have expected same, and unless such IS created, they will ever feel they have won the war, no matter how much they declare their willingness to quit!"

When asked, "Can the re-education of the

German people in the principles of democracy be conducted in such fashion that their own cooperation will be enlisted?" Mr. Cayce responded: "This depends upon from what standard. Who would set the standard for the democratic education of a Germany who considers itself ALREADY more wise than all the democracies! *Rather, teach them God, and how to search and find Him, and apply His principles in dealing with their fellow [humans].*" [Italics mine, js]

The specific questions continued: "Should educational materials be prepared ahead of time, and if so by what sort of representative group?" The sleeping Mr. Cayce replied: "We do not find this altogether feasible, without there having already been preconceived ideas
