
Dear Prayer and Healing Friends,

She was in a coma for quite some time and he was her executor and responsible for keeping her on life support. One day her family and doctors agreed it was time to let go, due to her declining condition. He tearfully recounted it had been 20 years since he had to make the hardest decision of his life, and that he still thought about it every day. He confided this was the first time he had spoken about her in many years. We recommended he continue to pray for her as the readings advise and to speak her name aloud.

Sometimes we forget how much we miss those who influenced our lives and have moved on to their next experience. It could be a word, a thought, an aroma, or even a street sign that awakens something in us that calls us to remembrance, to send out that love and gratitude. We don't need to wait for any particular day of the year to celebrate those we love, though many of us recall a birthday, a holiday, a day of their leave taking. We can celebrate their lives and impact on us each day.

In reading 281-12, Mr. Cayce gave a message for the group as a whole that deeply speaks to this. In prayer, we do not always see what is being

accomplished externally, especially concerning prayers to those who have passed on. He reminds us to be faithful. "Keep in that way, in patience, in persistence, in sincerity, in truth . . . Each should be patient first with self." Patience in the process of healing is essential. Emotions may come like waves, rising up and falling away; the best we can do is acknowledge them, and let them fall away gently. "Do not allow self to be so overcome in ANY manner as to miss that calling in Him; for He is faithful who has promised to be near." Anger energy can be blinding. How many of us have felt cheated, that someone was taken too soon? We do not know the reason, but this is where acceptance and faith step in. In those times, we turn within and remember that all is in our loving Creator's hands.

Let us be faith-filled. Let us honor our Creator's path, and the paths of those who have come before us. Let us accept the gift of being in the perfect place now.
