
Dear Prayer and Healing Friends,

In reading 281-39, given on January 12, 1938, Gertrude Cayce, (the reading conductor), began the reading with the suggestion that the Glad Helpers group was present for their *general work* in studying laws of spiritual or mental healing—the journey we're all on. Mr. Cayce reminded the group that in their study and application within their daily lives, there must be a more *unified* effort in bringing the consciousness of oneness and of peace so that healing might come. This raising of consciousness comes through *application* in our daily lives.

Mr. Cayce quoted John 14:27, where Jesus exclaims, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you." Peace that the Spirit offers is much different from the "temporary" peace that

the world can provide. This peace is a deep-rooted, enduring inner peace, derived from faith. Faith and peace bring comfort and trust in the Greater Plan and in each opportunity of growth that presents itself.

During times that can appear tumultuous within society, our country, or the world, oneness is more necessary than ever. Negativity is a strong habitual emotion we must guard against. A natural human tendency is to look for differences and divide ourselves from one another. Throughout the readings, we are told to remain open as a channel of blessings to others. When we allow ourselves to be "wounded" by the trials and tribulations of life, we have a tendency to close ourselves off and put up walls to protect ourselves from what we consider "outside threats" that have the potential to cause us more emotional, mental, or spiritual turmoil. Chapter 4, "Virtue and Understanding," in *A Search for God*, Book 1, tells us that the more open we are, the more power we are given. Without an open trusting heart, we will have little understanding for the situations that arise in daily life, robbing us of unity and peace.

Understanding is a spiritual gift that has the cleansing power of the Creative Forces. It is a "weapon" in the warfare for truth. The quality of understanding draws others to be honest and sincere with us. We have the ability to offer understanding even when another's purposes and intents are malicious. The readings affirm that what we see in others, we have within ourselves, or we wouldn't be able to see it. It is our duty, lesson, and purpose to learn to love one another in this lifetime.

Coming back to our original discussion of reading 281-39, we learn

that bringing these Divine gifts into our daily walk aids us in growing as one in the Christ light. "Make His presence a conscious thing in thy conversation in thy dealings with thy fellow man [humans]. For where the heart is, there the activity is to bring into the influence of those whom you meet that consciousness of that which is near and dear to thee."* Mr. Cayce is reiterating, "mind is the builder," thoughts are things, and what we dwell on continually is what will be reflected outwardly to others. Make the conscious choice to raise others to a higher place in consciousness, rather than diminishing them.

"Then as ye make the life, the love, the awareness of the Christ-Consciousness in the Father in thy daily life, more and more are ye able to give that which will bring into the experiences of others that same awareness."*

For this New Year, may we draw each other to the light within. May we pull one another out of the depths of indifference, hate, and fear, and open ourselves to the spirit of love and oneness.
