

### Ye Become Lights to Those That Sit in Darkness Savanna Barbarian

As we enter into a new season of spring, new life, and regeneration, we remind ourselves of the ever-changing world around us. Reading 281-30 given on February 17, 1937, contains the study of the Revelation. There was a crossover exchange during a question between the Healing Prayer Group and the first original study group #1 as they were working their way through the chapter, “Happiness,” in *A Search for God*, Book 2.

The Glad Helpers presented the question, “Do the seven angels described in Rev. 8-9 represent spiritual forces governing the various dimensional planes through which souls pass between incarnations on the earth?”\* Edgar Cayce’s answer: “This is a very good interpretation. Yes. . . . this explanation becomes a portion of another group’s study and activity in the lesson just being approached

on happiness. . . .”\* How often both of these groups cross-pollinated each other! They shaped a connected collective consciousness with one another. “As to how this must indeed be interpreted in the experience of each soul, whether considered in a material plane in which there is found the real essence of happiness or that in the interim when ye are looked over, or interpreted from that given by others—to be absent from the body-physical is to be present in the grace and glory and presence of divinity; or to be those influences that make for an activity in an influence without self.”\*

As individual souls it could be challenging to identify the real essence of a deeper soul level of happiness—not simply “happiness” on the material plane but, understanding a deep sense of peace, fulfillment, and connection

that transcends physical possessions or material circumstances. We can feel this immense joy in moments of laughter supporting and loving those around us. Immersion into nature, pure bliss walking through a wooded forest, watching the lapping waves on the beach, or listening to the sounds of water flowing through a woodland stream. Happiness on a non-material level could be as simple as creative expression, poetry, artistic activities, mindfulness, meditation, and prayer. Happiness comes through acts of kindness, such as the joy you experience helping someone in need or volunteering for a cause. Happiness on a non-material plane is often tied to emotional, spiritual, or experimental aspects of life, highlighting the importance of mental and emotional well-being over the accumulation of physical possessions.

"Now ye are studying yourself! Do not confuse the interpretation with that outside of thyself, but happiness is love of something outside of self! It may never be obtained, may never be known by loving only things within self or self's own domain!"\* Highlighting the importance of looking beyond oneself to find happiness, Mr. Cayce suggests that engagement with the outside world and connections with others is more fulfilling than self-centered introspection.

"Hence we find that in the expression then of those interims where there are the guiding influences of that we have loved, we have love—for this becomes then very definite. If ye have loved self-glory, if ye have loved the honor of the people more than those thoughts of the mental and spiritual and moral welfare, what manner of angels will direct thee between thy interims?"\* The Source urged reflection on what we value and love, encouraging a focus on deeper, moral, and spiritual considerations, rather than superficial or self-serving ideas. What if our choices and values significantly affect the guidance and influences we encounter in life?

"Study to show thyself approved unto God, the God in self, the God in thine own consciousness—that is creative in its essence, rightly divining and dividing the words of truth and light; keeping self unspotted from the world. And ye become lights to those that sit in darkness, to those that wander."\*
