During this dark period, Mr. Cayce's teachings on the importance of cultivating inner peace carried a timeless relevance, offering insight into how individual consciousness could influence the collective well-being. His emphasis on meditation, affirmation, prayer, and spiritual focus was rooted in the understanding that peace begins within, and that if enough people cultivate personal serenity, this can serve as a catalyst for societal harmony.

Mr. Cayce's message during that tumultuous era was clear: true peace is not merely an absence of conflict, but a conscious state of harmony accessible through spiritual practice. His recurring suggestion that individuals dedicate time to meditation and prayer was more than self-care; it was a powerful step toward

aligning consciousness with the ideals of love, understanding, and unity. The readings suggest that by nurturing inner calm, individuals could help change the collective vibration, fostering a world where compassion and cooperation triumph over division and violence.

The atrocities of WWII served as a stark reminder of humanity's capacity for destruction. crises, social unrest—the message Mr. Cayce conveyed remains as vital as ever. The same principles apply: change begins at the personal level, as each individual strives for inner peace, which then ripples outward into a more expansive inclusive societal shift. His readings remind us that meditation and prayer are not mere rituals but essential acts of spiritual responsibility, shaping a future we collectively create.

Mr. Cayce's timeless wisdom offers a profound reminder: peace is an active, conscious choice. In our current era, fostering inner tranquility can serve as a foundation for global harmony. As history has shown, the path to lasting peace starts within, and through conscious spiritual effort, we can each contribute to a more compassionate unified world—just as Mr. Cayce envisioned.

This is a heartfelt invitation to join us each week for the online Glad Helpers Zoom group* or the World Affairs Peace Group.** In reading 281-65, Mr. Cayce stressed the importance of using prayer and affirmations, especially in times of tumult around the globe. On May 14, 1944, the last reading given to the Glad Helpers gave nine affirmations. Each one contained the word "peace."

For the coming months we will use these affirmations for the month.

"This will soon require that whole time service of more than one individual be given and will require that certain definite [prayer] periods be given to individuals who may be asked to give themselves and their time to this phase of the work. Hinder no one from being a member of the group, but do have a definite circle that will meet the definite [prayer] periods at least once each and oftener when necessary.

As to affirmations: these should be towards that of peace through the next *six to eight to twelve months*. [Italics mine, the war ended August 14, 1945.] For then through this period will the earth and its peoples be passing through the most strenuous period of the world's history since the Master walked in the earth."
