Prayer: A Pathway to Peace—Continued Savanna Barbarian

In the historical tapestry of 1934, the world stood at a crossroads marked by economic hardship, political upheaval, and a yearning for stability. The Great Depression cast a shadow over nations, fostering uncertainty and despair. Mr. Cayce's reading from November 1, 1934, emphasized the imperative need of inner peace as the foundation for global harmony.

"We have the group as gathered here, as a group of Glad Helpers, and therein seeking to aid others. First, we would give not as that of self-praise—but let each know: As good has been accomplished in the lives and the experiences of those they have sought to help, this should be each as a verification of the promises that have been given."* Mr. Cayce stressed humility and the importance of peace, aligning human efforts with

Divine promises of harmony.

There is a strong emphasis on spiritual order: "In the work, then, let each thing be done in order, and keeping that humbleness of spirit, that oneness of purpose, that desire to see in those that seek through such channels the glorifying of the consciousness of the Christ-Spirit dwelling with each."* This calls for disciplined spiritual practice rooted in humility and purpose, aligning individual efforts with the divine plan for peace. Mr. Cayce suggested that peace begins within—by cultivating the Christ-Spirit and a sincere purpose to serve others.

Active engagement or application in our daily experience is advocated, "Let each, then, be not slothful in the activities, not

negligent, but rather let each be up and doing, with a mind to serve in whatsoever channel or manner the opportunity presents itself."* While inner peace is essential, action—guided by Divine service—is equally vital. Mr. Cayce's Ideals transcend passive hope; it's about active participation in creating a more peaceful world by embodying Divine love and mercy in regard to others.

The heart of this reading shines forth in the spiritual directives hidden within the affirmation given, "The Father that worketh in me, supplyeth the needs of the body, of the mind, of the soul, even as I work His ways."* This mirrors the Divine Will. Through prayer, love, and service, the ripple effect can help alleviate global unrest.

At this pivotal historical time, Europe lurched toward instability, with fascist ideologies gaining ground in Germany and Italy. The aftermath of World War I still loomed large, and the economic devastation of the Depression had eroded trust in political and economic systems. Social unrest, rising nationalism, and fears of war characterized much of the global landscape. In the midst of these tumultuous conditions, Mr. Cayce emphasized inner peace and Divine purpose, seen as a counterbalance—a spiritual anchor—urging individuals and nations to

seek harmony within themselves as a pathway to peace in the world.

The emphasis on prayer and Divine guidance echoes the widespread longing for a unifying force. The core message suggests that peace is not merely a political construct but a Divine principle that begins within each person and community. In a time of widespread despair, the readings emphasized that the key to peace resides in an inner harmony cultivated through prayer, humility, active service, and Divine alignment.

Peace in the world is fundamentally rooted in spiritual consciousness. Peace flows from Divine union, guiding individuals to embody love and mercy. The Divine plan, as Mr. Cayce communicated, beckons us to trust in the Divine strength and to serve selflessly. Every act motivated by love and humility reverberates beyond the individual, creating waves of peace that can heal nations.

A call to action speaks loudly in this affirmation: "As I, O God, forgive those that trespass against me, wilt Thou forgive them that do err against thee and against me, giving them life and hope and faith."*
