

Prayer: A Pathway to Peace—Part 4 Savanna Barbarian

Work reading 254-91, given on June 28, 1936, at the Fifth Annual Members Congress, offers a clear message that is valuable for us today as we meet the challenges set before us.

"There is a period just ahead in which there will be given the greater opportunities for service by each and every A.R.E. member. This is not only owing to the general conditions of an unsettled nature but to the termination of a period and the beginning of a period when there is to be the LIVING by individuals of that which has prompted them."

Mr. Cayce spoke to a time of transformation and service, emphasizing an urgent call to action centered on peace. As we face a world in transition, we are encouraged to seize opportunities for meaningful service not merely as a response to instability but as a proactive

commitment to fostering peace. This journey begins with living authentically, guided by values that transcend personal gain or avoidance.

" . . . Not as ones seeking for self-exaltation, not as individuals seeking for an easy way, not as individuals seeking for a manner or a means of escaping their own selves; but rather as in using their understanding, their comprehension, their knowledge, their love, their patience, their long-suffering, in such ways and manners that there may not indeed be the perishing of hope and faith in the earth."

By focusing on understanding, knowledge, love, and patience, we become architects of peace, building bridges between conflicting forces within ourselves and our surroundings. The emphasis on enduring virtues encourages

a resilience that counters despair and division, by nurturing an inner tranquility that radiates outward.

This reading calls for an awakening where personal growth aligns with collective harmony, promoting peace as both a personal responsibility and a global imperative. In resisting the allure of self-exaltation and seeking instead to serve others, we create ripples of peace that sustain hope. Mr. Cayce's vision becomes a blueprint for achieving peace—transforming internal and external chaos into a harmonious state of being where faith and hope can thrive across the earth.

Mr. Cayce reminds us against motivations driven by ego, convenience, or avoidance. This reading encourages introspection, urging us to transcend selfish desires or escapism. It suggests the importance of facing personal challenges and embracing growth without seeking shortcuts. The reading emphasizes the use of innate virtues and skills such as understanding, knowledge, love, patience, and endurance. It calls for a mature application of these qualities, fostering growth, transformation, and peace. Long-suffering here implies perseverance and resilience in the face of difficulties. Sustaining hope and faith globally is a much-needed mission, especially today.

"I AM my brother's keeper! That should be the cry that should be in the heart of every member, every individual, 'I AM MY BROTHER'S KEEPER!' Then so live, so act, so conduct thyself in thy dealings with thy fellow man day by day that they who are astray may be set aright. Not those who are astray only according to THINE own interpretations, but those who are seeking!" Let this be our clarion call, as we put aside conflict and create oneness.

"For He giveth good and evil unto all, and ye choose through the WILL thy relationships—as to whether they shall be for self-exaltation, self-glorification, self-indulgence, self-gratification, or for the love of life, of truth, of hope, of honor, of virtue, of patience, of brotherly love. Ye yourselves show forth these in the manners, the ways ye deal with thy fellow man! Forgive, if ye would be forgiven. Be patient, if ye would have thy Father be patient with thee."

"Will ye be ready to set that as the standard?" We are challenged to make peace our guiding principle. By prioritizing "others, Lord, not myself but others," we embody selflessness and compassion, both essential for manifesting "the glory of the Father . . . in the earth."

Let us be vessels of peace, ready to answer, "Here am I, use me."
