### Prayer: A Pathway to Peace—Part 7 Savanna Barbarian

"In the beginning when chaos existed in the creating of the earth, the Spirit of God moved over the face of same and out of chaos came the world . . ." This single sentence from reading 3976-8 given on January 15, 1932, opens with a psychology of peace. Before form, before nations, before conflict, there is movement of Spirit over chaos. Peace, in this light, is not the absence of disturbance; it is the presence of Spirit creating it.

The reading then turns to humanity's role: "With man's advent into the world, then personalities, individualities, began to find expressions in SUBDUING the earth . . . the result was the differences of opinions, the various sects, sets, classes and races."\* Here is both privilege and peril. The same impulse that can bring harmony into matter can also turn us against our fellow beings. Peace, then, is not

naive denial of differences. The reading fully acknowledges, "As the earth was peopled, and the abilities of expansion were able to bring the various groups, or associations of groups or nations, they COULD—and DID—withdraw into themselves, and build for themselves in the various portions of the world that known as the periods of advancement of some particular group of peoples."\* Human history is a tapestry of competing powers, ideals, and territories. Yet even within this fragmentation lies a prophetic warning and a higher possibility.

In our own age, the reading continues, ". . . so that the man upon the other side of the world is as much the neighbor as the man next door . . ."\* this idea pushes us to a decision-point.

Will we continue to "... induce, force or compel, one portion of the world to think as the other ... " \* or dare to "... dwell together as brethren with one bond of sympathy, or one standard for all? " \* The path to peace, this reading suggests, begins at the beginning, letting Spirit move once more over our present chaos.

In this challenging time, the oldest moral summons still points toward healing: "Where IS thy brother? His blood CRIES to me from the ground! " \* That urgent appeal, answered sometimes in denial with, "Am I my brother's keeper? " \* demands an ethical reorientation: peace is not merely absence of conflict but the vigilant responsibility we owe one another. True concord arises when we accept that "Thou shalt love the Lord Thy God with all thine heart, thy neighbor AS thyself! " \* —a directive that binds interior devotion to outward compassion.

This vision reframes power. Too often, "Man's answer to everything has been POWER—Power of money, Power of position, Power of wealth, " \* yet the reading insists that, "This has NEVER been GOD'S way, will never be God's way. " \* If peace is the aim, then accumulation and domination are revealed as failed instruments. Instead, the pathway to durable harmony

runs through individual transformation: each person cultivating the little acts of empathy that, "... the little leaven leaven[eth] the whole lump. " \* Quiet, consistent care for others multiplies into social change. When we recognize that, "HE is thine neighbor, and thou must answer for him! " \* we accept ethical accountability across distance and difference. This is not a sentimental plea but a strategic ethic: societies that practice mutual acceptance of responsibility reduce the grievances that foster violence. The injunction that, "... Thou shalt love the Lord Thy God with all thine heart, thy neighbor AS thyself! " This [is] the whole law, this [is] the whole answer to the world, to each and every soul " \* offers a synthesis—spiritual devotion and neighborly love as the building blocks of peace. To build peace, then, is both inward work and outward practice: to make mercy habitual, to prefer justice over privilege, and to treat every person as one for whom we must answer. In doing so, we answer the ancient cry with action rather than silence, transforming lament into lasting reconciliation.
